NEW DISEASE INFO: RED LEAF BLOTCH IN ALMONDS

UC Extension Specialist Dr. Flo Trouillas will join us to present on red leaf blotch in almonds. This disease was first found in California in 2024 and has been detected as far north as Butte County. Dr. Trouillas will cover the biology of the pathogen, symptom development through the season, and best management practices for the disease.
